<p>We can improve Accessibility for volunteers with disabilities at your organization:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Attitudinal Change – We can provide information on using respectful people first language or offer common tips on disability etiquette. We can help you discover your organization’s overall attitude regarding volunteers with disabilities and provide interventions for improvement. ▪ Physical Access – we can direct you to resources for a site visit to assess your building for physical access. ▪ Assistive Technology – we can suggest various assistive technology resources for people with disabilities such as Write-Out Loud or Dragon Naturally Speaking. ▪ Web site Access – We can refer you to people who can determine if your website is accessible to people with various disabilities including visually impaired, learning disabilities and limited motor control. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Direct Service - We do not offer direct services. ▪ Involvement with potential volunteers - We do not directly recruit volunteers. ▪ We do not screen, interview, place or supervise volunteers. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ You can place individuals with disabilities at your organization. ▪ You can let us know how you are doing, i.e., what networking contacts you have made or how many volunteers you have placed. ▪ You can continue to attend LINC meetings and/or match-making meetings as appropriate. ▪ You can promote our project at your web site or publicize through your newsletters and other public venues.

<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Assistance with placing volunteers - We can provide an example of a job description and a list of legal questions you can and cannot ask a potential volunteer with a disability.▪ Information and Referral – We can provide referrals to a variety of resources. <p>We can provide public relations support.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Publicize and recruit - We can publicize and recruit for volunteers with disabilities for your projects. We can help with flyer development as well as post on our website. <p>Trainings on Disability Issues:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Trainings: We can provide resources for speakers to conduct trainings on needed disability topics such as the Americans with Disabilities Act, the prevalence and history of disability, various disabilities and assistive technology. <p>Local Inclusion Network Collaboratives and Match Making meetings</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Host and facilitate - We can host and facilitate Local Inclusion Network Collaboratives (LINC) and match making meetings. A match making meeting might be between an agency looking for volunteers and an agency interested in placing volunteers.
